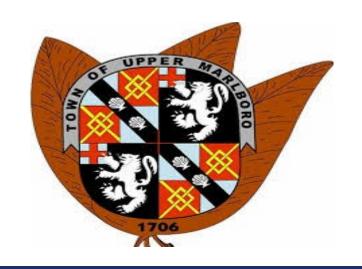

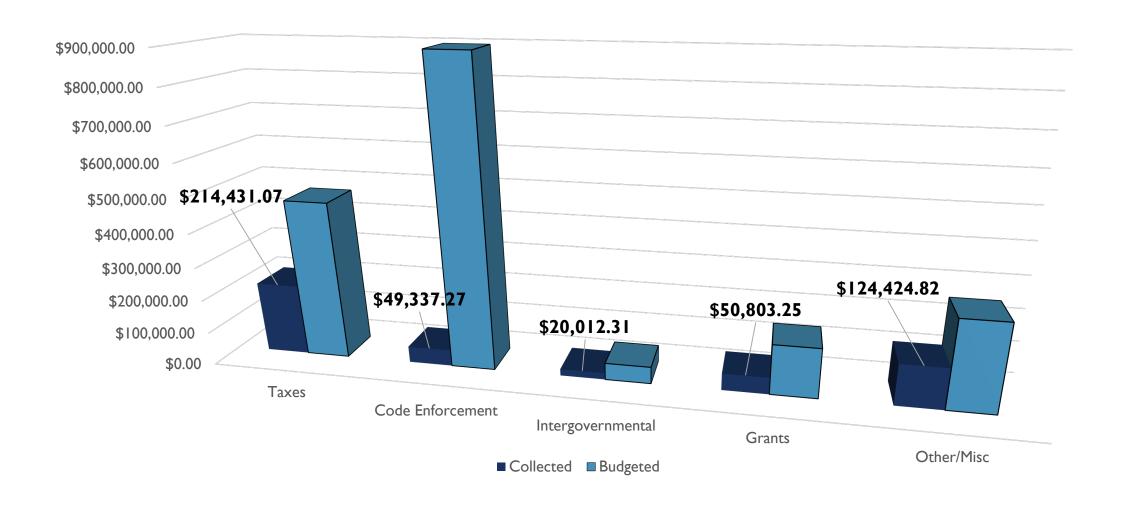
The Town currently has four (4) available/vacant positions approved within FY19 budget

The Town of Upper Marlboro's fiscal year begins July 1st and ends June 30th of every year

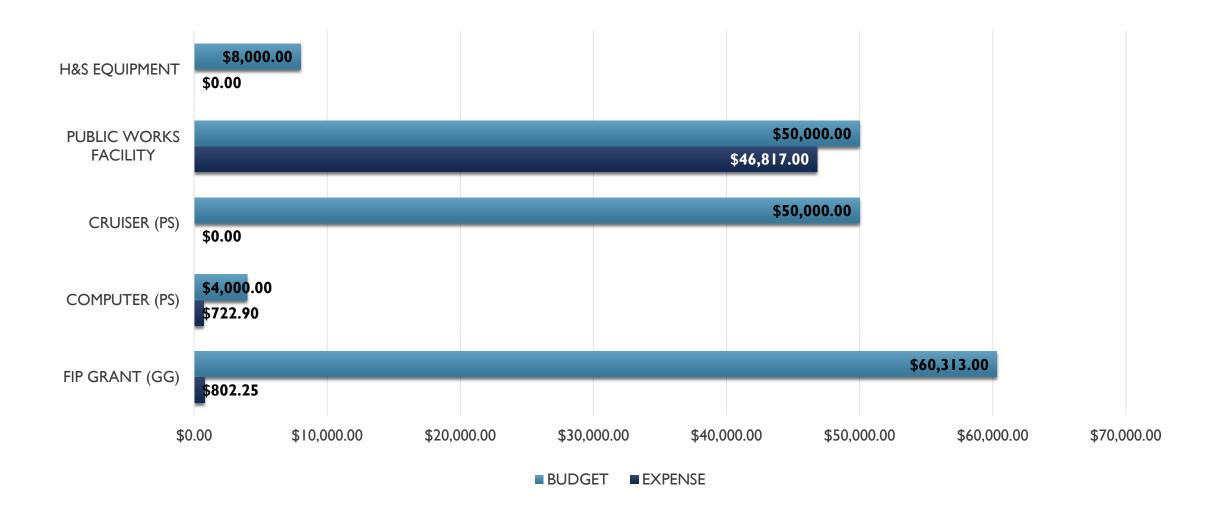
FY2019 GENERAL FUND OVERVIEW/ANTICIPATED PROJECTS

- Economic development of Main Street...

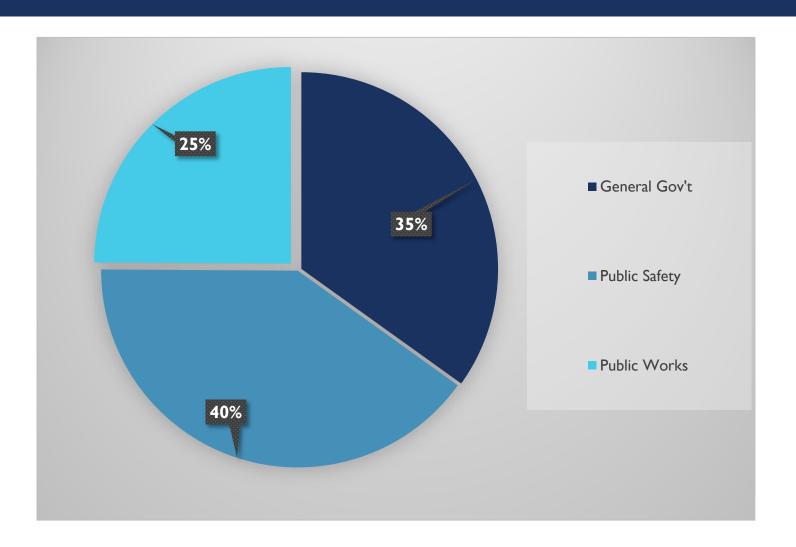
FY2019 GENERAL FUND REVENUES



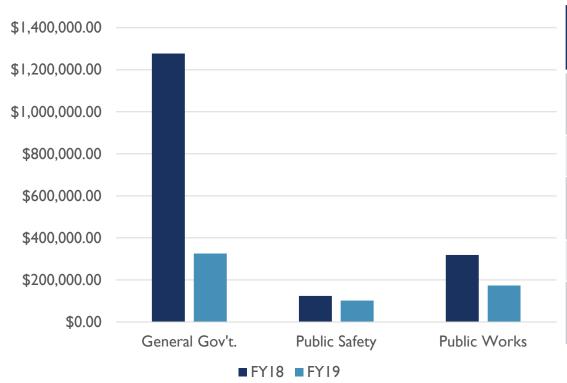
FY2019 CAPITAL OUTLAY EXPENSES



FY2019 EXPENDITURE BUDGET

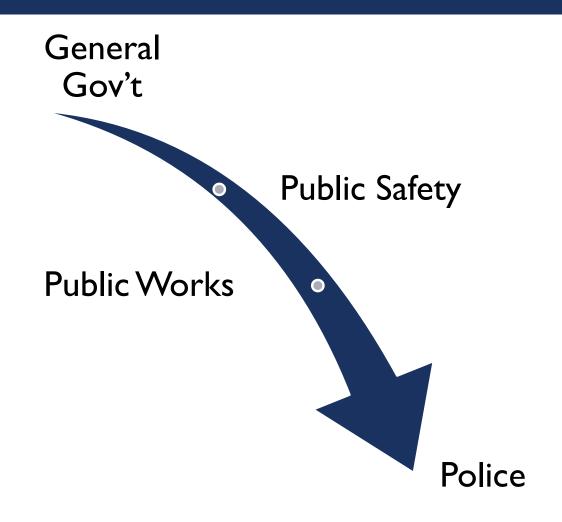

- Mid Year budget vs actual numbers
 - Revenues are 24.96% collected
 - **32.66**% of total budget spent
- The Town is still awaiting for...

 - 4th quarter utility franchise fees
 - Monthly taxes
 - Parking meter revenue from proposed increases
