School House Pond Clean Water Project: The County's Clean Water team gave a brief presentation to the Board regarding the County Clean Water Initiative and the School House Pond Clean Water Project. President Turner invited the team to give this presentation at a Town Meeting to the residents.

Public Works Facility Project: The project is moving along nicely, with all paperwork taken care of. Project Manager Fran McLellan provided the Board with a July completion date.

Citizens Guide: President Turner advised she spoke with Commissioner Pennoyer regarding this initiative and wished to table this project for now.

FY2019 Budget: President Turner advised she sat down with the Accountant to have an in-depth conversation with Department Heads regarding their budgets. This draft budget also provides some funding to hire additional Police Officer and Public Works or other staff as needed during the Annexation process. This budget also does not pull from the reserves for capital purchases and generates a surplus. President Turner requested the Commissioners reach out to her or the Town Accountant with questions or concerns.
